

MBSC Sailing Report - week ended 18th April 2010

Saturday 17th April 2010

Seven lasers, five mirrors and three handicap boats turned out for another glorious and eventful afternoons racing in the bay.

Race 1:

The laser fleet saw yet another keen battle at the front between John Woolcock, Jeremy Williams and Greg Harris, each finishing in that order. Early pressure from Nick Stoten faded after hitting a mark and Graham Cousins dashed his hopes by going aground on Hogus.

In the Mirrors, Jane and Isobel Goodhead battled it out with Simon Chapman sailing single handed. Jane won the first race with Simon close behind and Rob Bode coming in third.

Race 2:
