

ARRIVAL DIRECTIONS AT MOUNTS BAY FOR THE MUSTO PERFORMANCE SKIFF FLEET.

You will probably be approaching West Cornwall from the east on the A30 heading for Penzance. These directions start after you have passed the town of Hayle and you will see the road sign “A30 Penzance”. You are approximately 5 miles from Marazion. Continue on the A30 and look out for the small hamlets of “Canon’s Town”, “Whitecross” and “Cockwells”. As you pass through them on the A30 look to the left and you might get your first sight of the castle on St. Michael’s Mount.

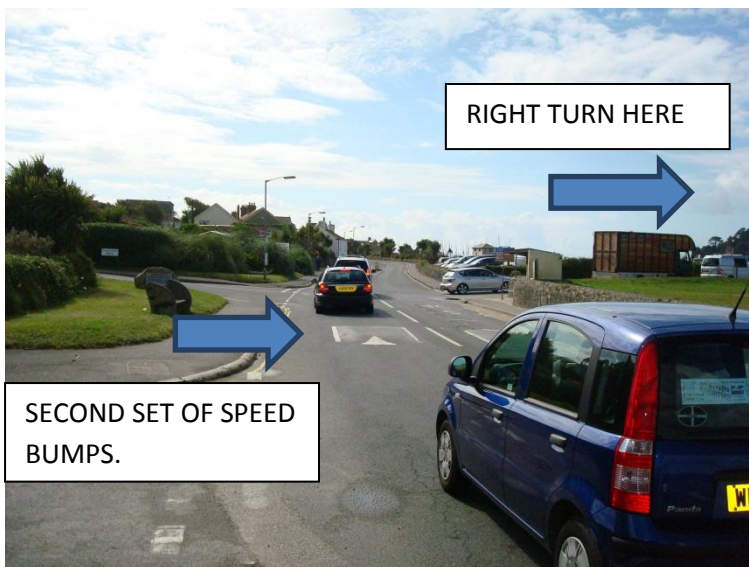
Continue on the A30 through the village of Crowlas (40 mph speed limit). At the next roundabout (Newtown Roundabout) take the second exit to “Marazion” (below) signposted “Marazion Car Parks” and “St. Michael’s Mount”.



At the T junction by a bridge (below) turn left over the railway line signposted “Marazion Car Parks” and “St. Michael’s Mount”. You will be heading towards St. Michael’s Mount.



After this junction you will have Mount's Bay on your right hand side and Marazion Marsh to your left (40 mph speed limit). Continue until you enter the 30 mph speed limit. Immediately after the **second set of speed bumps** take a right turn into the FOLLY CAR PARK and the car park attendant will direct you left to the entrance to the Championship dinghy park (location map on this web site).



(Please note if you arrive after dark or early in the morning the Folly Car Park will be locked – you will need to carry on into Marazion and take the next right into the Slipway Car Park and turn right again past the blue and white kiosk to the end of the car park near the MBSC Club dinghy park. You are advised to move the boat to the Folly Car Park in the morning.)
